Whitlocksworthy to Sutton Cross, South Milton

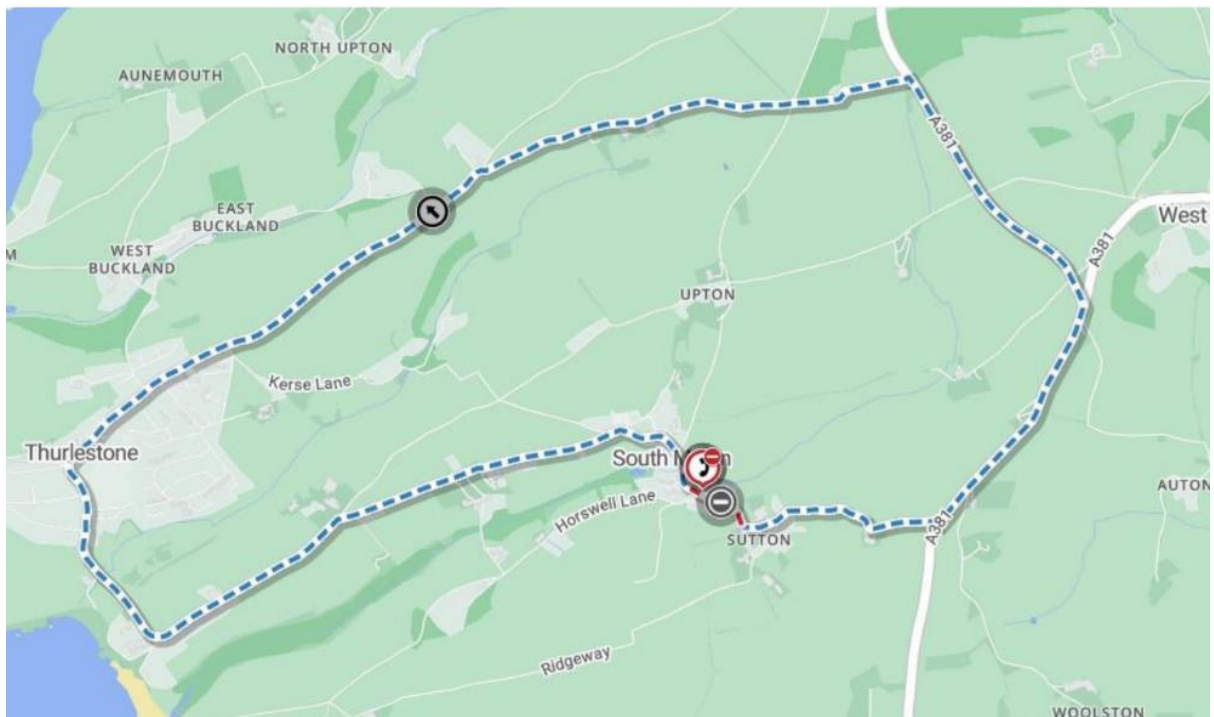

West Alvington cross to Ilbert road, West Alvington (outside prospect house)

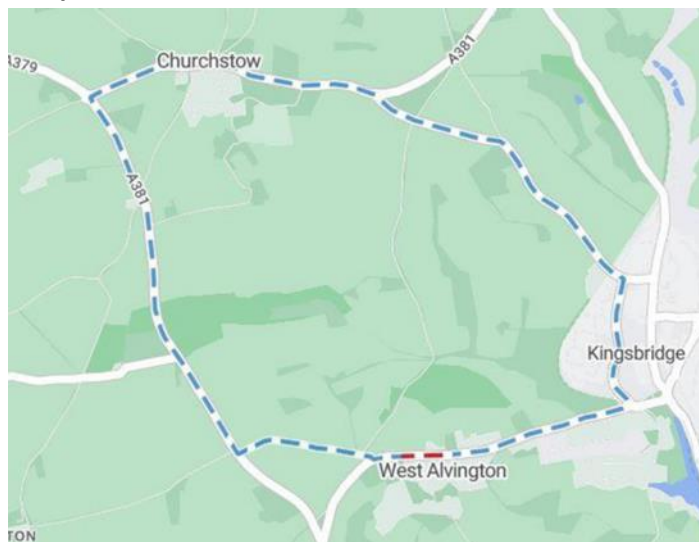

2. I will be attending both the Devolution White Paper meeting (for smaller councils) on 30<sup>th</sup> January and the parish forum on 27<sup>th</sup> March.
3. A topple test has recently been confirmed by South Hams District Council regarding the headstones in all closed burial grounds in the South Hams. This will ensure that any headstones that are not fully secure or those leaning at precarious angles will be made safe.
4. In September 2024, I was offered a bursary to study for the Principles of Internal Audit Local Councils, on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024 I received a certificate confirming this course has been completed and passed.
5. South Hams District Council Thermal Imaging Camera Hire Scheme Winter 2024/25:
  - As part of our ambitions to make homes more environmentally friendly while helping people through the ongoing cost of living crisis, South Hams District Council have four thermal imaging cameras available for use by town and parish councils, or local communities on a free to borrow basis.
  - **Applications to hire one can be made by Town and Parish Councils or organised community groups only and cameras should be used in group settings.**
  - Cameras are available to borrow for up to two weeks. It's expected that applicants will use the cameras with local residents to survey several homes within the hire period. Full details can be found on the South Hams District Council website.
