

1. Road Warden Scheme:

There are now four qualified people for the Road Warden role. Cllrs Dennis & Lees are booked in for a course on 15th November. Across the four parishes we still have ten volunteer spaces left that can be paid for by Devon County Council. There are currently no qualified people living in the parish of South Milton.

2. Localities Applications for community related projects

Cllr Gilbert has approved £500 financial support from his localities budget to enable the parish to purchase tools and equipment for repair and maintenance works.

3. Public Right of Way/Slurry Pit Update:

Further to the July meeting we requested advice from our PROW warden and received the following information:

All slurry lagoons should be fenced regardless of the presence of a right of way. There should also be a sign saying stating the presence of the lagoon.

Regarding the water course – a slurry lagoon should not be sited less than 10m from a water course.

**A3122 COLLATON DOWN BLACKAWTON
RESURFACING**

This letter is to give you some detailed information about the forthcoming resurfacing which will be commencing on the A3122 at Collaton Down, Blackawton. These works are being undertaken by our Highways Partners Tarmac.

Due to the nature of the works a **nighttime** road closure is required and the diversionary route for traffic will be signposted and advance signs will also be placed on the Highway. Emergency access will be maintained, as well as access for residents within the closure.

The planned on-site working hours will be.

- **Monday 2nd September until Saturday 20th September.**
The existing road surface will be removed and replaced in sections.
- **Timings**
On **Monday 2nd September** because of events in Dartmouth, the road will be closed from **10pm until 6am.**

Every other weekday the road will be closed from **7pm until 6am.** The road will be open over the weekends, but there will be sections which may be temporary in nature and care driving must be taken when using the route.

Please see the road closure and works area highlighted in **red** on the map below, there will be a signed diversion route which is shown on the map in **blue**. Drivers with local knowledge will be able to use alternative side roads but these will not be publicly advertised for safety.
